# Aligned Puff Stitch

Crochet Pattern (UK Terms)


#### You will need:

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#### Useful abbreviations to read pattern

- Crochet Hook 5/6mm
- 25g DK wool colour of your choice
- St stitch Sts stitches Slst Slipstitch StM Stitch Marker
- Ch chain
- dc double crochet
- htr half treble crochet
- YO − yarn over

#### To make a puff stitch:

\* YO and insert hook into stitch, pull up a loop to the height of previous stitch or ch3 at start of row – repeat from \* 4 times, YO and draw through ALL loops on the hook

## Pattern (multiple of 2 ch)

If you are joining to the other squares, then make sure that the foundation row is 8 inches (in multiple of 2). If your initial row is smaller than 8 inches, then add multiples of 2 chains until it makes 8 inches in width.

**[ROW 0].** [FOUNDATION ROW] Chain 26 (or a multiple of 2 which reaches 8 inches in width)

**[ROW 1].** Dc into 2<sup>nd</sup> st from hook, \* ch1 and skip st (this creates a ch-1sp), 1dc into next st – repeat from \* across 25 stitches

**[ROW 2].** Ch2 (add StM into 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch and repeat for all the rest of the rows so you know which is the last st), turn work, work a **Puff stitch** into the next ch1-sp [YO and insert hook into stitch, pull up a loop to the height of previous stitch or ch3 at start of row – repeat from \* 4 times, YO and draw through ALL loops on the hook then ch1 to lock], \* ch1, work **Puff stitch** into next ch1-sp – repeat from \* all the way across the row, htr into last st on row

**[ROW 3].** Ch1, turn work, 1dc into top of htr from previous row, ch1, 1dc into next ch1-sp (between the puff stitches in previous row), ch1 – repeat from \* across with 1dc into last st

[ROW 4]. Repeat row 2 and 3 until work measures 8 inches in height

**[ROW 5].** DO NOT TIE OFF – work 1 dc evenly spaced around the entire edge of the piece making sure you put 3dc into the corner stitch. Slipstitch to join – tie off and weave in ends.
